Ehis, A2S program coordinator in Nigeria, smiled and explained that she could slow down — no one was coming to take her plate away. With a full stomach, she was able to move into the after-school program and concentrate on her education and play.

Miracle is just one example of the many children that are being served by A2S in Benin City. According to a 2012 report released by Save the

Children, "Nigeria has the third highest number of malnourished children in the world, with 26 percent of children under the age of five severely malnourished." Your support can keep her from becoming a statistic.
